

Job Posting for Alliston Alliance Church Lead Pastor position

Located within the Town of New Tecumseth, Alliston Alliance Church (AAC) is one of the churches within the Central Canadian District of the Christian and Missionary Alliance (C&MA) in Canada. Alliston is a rapidly growing community about one hour north of Toronto. It has a population of approximately 20,000 people. Major employers in the area include Honda Canada, Baxter Canada and Gibson Transport. Alliston also boasts one of the largest high schools in Ontario (outside of the GTA) and several public elementary and Christian schools.

We believe that AAC exists to Build Believers, Equip Workers and Love Seekers. We are seeking a Lead Pastor who has the leadership skills and character to lead the church to fulfill its mission and vision. The successful candidate will be familiar with, and unconditionally support, the C&MA Statement of Faith, Constitution and Values. The candidate must be licensed by the Central Canadian District to be hired for the position.

We prefer someone with Master's degree seminary education, but will consider those with college level. They will possess at least 5 years experience in leading a congregation that has experienced growth and is healthy - spiritually, relationally and missionally.
